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### **NFCC TO PROVIDE COUNSELING AND EDUCATION SERVICES FOR U.S. SERVICE MEMBERS AND THEIR FAMILIES THROUGH THE MILITARY ONESOURCE PROGRAM**

**Silver Spring, MD** – The National Foundation for Credit Counseling (NFCC) is pleased to announce the establishment of a financial education and counseling relationship as part of the Military OneSource Program (MOS). Administered By Ceridian Corporation under a Department of Defense contract, MOS is designed to promote the overall well-being of military family members and provide them with the resources to handle life’s everyday challenges. Primary to the NFCC Member Agencies’ role is financial literacy education, money management, the proper handling of debt, and the training and assistance with the processes involved in home purchase and finance.

A carefully planned promotion to the military universe will strive to create a growing awareness of the help and services that are available through the MOS program. Through the relationship with the NFCC, counseling will be provided by certified counselors through NFCC’s network of participating nonprofit Member Agencies located nationwide on a face-to-face basis, or by phone. Further, arrangements will be provided so that this special service can be utilized by service members in more remote areas of the country.
